For more than 40 years, Piggly Wiggly was the sole retailer of Mepkin Abbey Eggs, production the monks began to phase out more than a year ago.

“Our relationship with Mepkin Abbey has always been mutually rewarding,” said David R. Schools, president and CEO of Piggly Wiggly Carolina Co. “We provided an outlet for the brothers of the monastery to retain their self-sufficiency while they provided Piggly Wiggly with local products that tasted great! We’re thrilled we can continue to grow that relationship.”

Known for their sweet, woody flavor and distinct aroma, guests can find Mepkin Abbey’s fresh oyster mushrooms – named for their shape and taste - in three area Piggly Wiggly locations: 100 W Main St. in Moncks Corner, 1981 Riviera Dr. in Mount Pleasant, and Newton Farms in Johns Island. In the following months, the mushrooms will be made available at additional locations as supply allows. The Abbey’s mushrooms will be sold in six-ounce packages featuring recipes from the Moncks Corner monastery’s own cook, Brother Joe.

After deciding to phase out their egg production operation, the monks debated several ways to replace the lost revenue before settling on mushrooms, which are both environmentally-friendly and healthy – two attributes that correspond with the order’s core values.
